**SELECTION OF VILLAGE AGRICULTURAL WORKER
ON CONTRACTUAL BASIS.**

The Deputy Director of Agriculture, Kendrapara invites application from eligible candidates for engagement as Village Agricultural Workers(VAW) on contractual basis in the Revenue District.

1. Educational Qualification

A candidate must have passed +2 Science or Intermediate in Science or +2 Vocational examinations in the field of Agriculture oriented subject such as Horticulture, Crop production, Sericulture & Farm mechanic from a recognized institution.

2. Age Limit

The candidate applying for the post of VAW shall not be less than 20 years of Age and more than 32 years of Age on 01.01.2011 i.e. should have born between 01-01-1979 to 31.12.1990. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC/ST/Women/3 years in case of SEBC candidates and 10 years in case of orthopedically handicapped candidates.

3. Terms and conditions

A candidate shall be

- a) A citizen of India and permanent resident of Orissa.
- b) Of good character, sound physique and free from organic defect.
- c) Must be able to speak, read and write Oriya and shall have passed a test in Oriya equivalent to the middle school standard or shall have passed M.E. standard with Oriya language.
- d) Must know cycling
- e) Should preferably come from rural area and come from small or marginal farmers family
- f) The selected candidates will be engaged on contract, for a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 5200/- P.M and will under go in-service training in RITEs of the State.
- g) The candidates so engaged cannot claim for their transfer to other district.
- h) The candidates engaged on contractual basis shall not claim for regularization of their service either during the period of their engagement or after its termination.

4. Method of Selection

Selection of the candidates shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the +2 Science or Intermediate in Science or +2 Vocational Examinations in the field of Agriculture.

If percentages of marks secured by a candidate in +2 Science / Intermediate in Science and marks secured by another candidate in +2 Vocational Course in the field of agriculture is equal then candidates having +2 Vocational course in the field of Agriculture shall be preferred.

5. Positions to be filled up

The number of positions to be filled up in the Agriculture Range, Kendrapara is as follows, which is provisional and subject to change.

of which, reserved for women	3	3	2	7	15

Note: There is no specific reservation for men under any category. The fact that a certain number of seats are reserved for women **does not** mean that the remaining seats are reserved only for men.

The reservations are applied considering the whole state as a unit. At present 1% of posts of VAW to be kept reserved for physically handicapped category as per G.A Department Resolution No. 3404/G.A dtd. 13.02.2006 and such reservation will apply to only those orthopedically handicapped candidates who fail in OA and OL (MNR) categories as defined in the resolution.


6. Documents to be submitted

True copies of the following documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer not below the rank of Class-II (Group-B) and signed by the candidates shall be attached with application form.

- H.S.C Examination or equivalent certificate in support of age and date of birth.
- Certificate in support of passing +2 Science/Intermediate in Science/+2 Vocational Examination
- Mark sheets in support of qualifying examinations (H.S.C Examination or equivalent and +2 Science/Intermediate in Science/+2 Vocational Examination)
- Caste certificate from competent Revenue Authority in case of SC/ST/SEBC candidates
- Certificate claiming to have come from rural area and small or marginal farmers' family to be obtained from Assistant Agriculture Officer of the block.
- Character Certificate from two Group- B Officers (not below Class-II)
- Certificate of Good conduct from the institution in which he/she last studied.
- If employed, "No-objection Certificate" from the employer is to be submitted.
- Two copies of attested passport size recent photographs.

7. Last date of submission of Application

The candidates fulfilling the above requirements should apply by post or in person in the prescribed format available in the Office of Deputy Director of Agriculture; Ranges/District Agriculture Officer with required documents as indicated above only to the Deputy Director of Agriculture, Kendrapara by 5.00 P.M. of **16th April, 2011. A candidate can apply in any one district of the state but not more.** Applications received after the above stipulated date or incomplete in any respect or applying directly to the office of the Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Orissa, Bhubaneswar are liable to be rejected summarily.
